

PAEDIATRICS: PATIENT FEES

Please Note: Suggested fee schedule is only a guide and actual gaps charged are at the discretion of the practitioner. Any procedure such as skin excisions, Mirena insertion, Implanon insertion/removal, iron infusions, intravenous medications, ambulatory BP fitting and wound care will incur an additional out of pocket fee to cover consumables. Please speak to our nurses or receptionists to provide an accurate estimate of costs.

Privately billed patients have a clinic Administration & Consumables Surcharge added to their consult fees. The surcharge may vary periodically at the discretion of the clinic. It is in addition to any gap payments listed below.

Surcharges apply when using credit/debit card (fees vary depending on the type of card and the bank).

The State Government has recently decided to impose a payroll tax liability in respect of GP billings. There have also been significant rising costs associated with operating a medical practice. As a result of these changes, GPs have been forced to revise their billing policies as follows (effective 1 July 2024):
